### Roof

BNF Roofing have sealed the gutter / gulley – and there have been no leaks to date. There are potentially six other gulleys that have rusting, and these will be kept under review. Quotes are now being sort to redecorate the meeting room so this can be restored to full use.

#### Windows

PH has now met with the Director of The Westminster Diocesan Property Services, Clive Horscroft, who has confirmed that our insurance policy will not cover the breakage claim. This was expected. In view of the length of time it has taken to reach this decision Clive will now request a new quote for the replacement of the two panes as well as the 'internal' filming of all large panes. The replacement / filming will fulfil the insurer's requirements and prevent potential danger to WCC users in case of any future breakage. It was agreed that the cost will be split equally between the two Churches. Additional funds may need to be transferred into the Sinking Fund.

## Steel Supports / Metal Pillars on Outside of Building

Clive Horscroft has also expressed concern about the rust build-up on the base of the metal pillars. Clive will produce a report. However, in the meantime TP will wire brush them and apply a coat of red oxide. The steel supports have 'more life in them' and replacements are not necessary.
